Well done, good and faithful servant... and my friend.

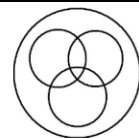

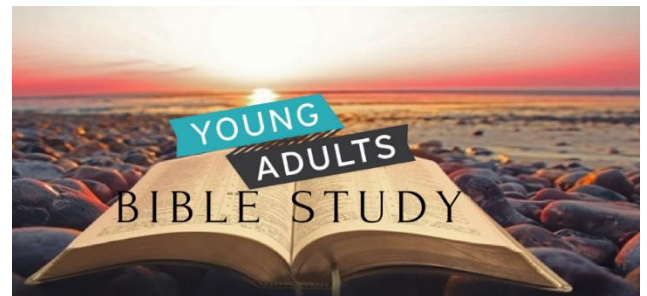
