Dear Friends.

FROMTHE PASTOR In my personal opinion (which I happen to hold in high regard[©]) the month of March leaves a lot to be desired, as a general rule. The weather is usually a roller-coaster of suckiness, from the worst of winter weather to teasing bits

of springtime, only to be thrown back into arctic nonsense. Yay. That, and we're still a long way from summer's laid-back vibe... a long way from no school and warm nights and open windows. The one saving grace of March is that it isn't February. That, and with each passing day, we get more daylight. Yes, the days start to really feel like they're getting longer as the sun gets up ever earlier and sets ever later. And that, my friends, is how we know that Easter is coming.

"The first Sunday after the first full moon after the spring equinox..." Repeat until you've got it memorized. That little formula is what determines when we celebrate our Lord's resurrection at Easter each year. (Actually, we celebrate Jesus' resurrection *every* Sunday, every *day*, as Christians, but we do recognize one special Easter Festival Day every spring.) The formula, though somewhat convoluted sounding, actually makes some sense. The Christian faith to which we are heirs, expressed in the Western Church of antiquity, was most firmly established in the northern hemisphere. With the sun's passing the equator (or, more correctly stated, as the northern half of the earth tilts back toward the sun) we in this part of the world begin to feel the earth's warming and we know that life is getting ready to spring forth again from the dormant ground. The first full moon of Spring reminds us of the light shining even in the darkest night, even in the face of death. Sounds like Easter to me! Hence, the formula: we celebrate Easter on the first Sunday after the first full moon after the spring equinox.

This year, Easter comes on April 20th. That means that our forty-day season of Lent, that preparatory time of examining our faith and readying ourselves for Easter, begins with Ash Wednesday, March 5th. We get ready for Easter by first admitting our own mortality, our own frailty and the fact that we are people in need of God's grace. (Considering how I generally feel about March, it couldn't be a better fit!) We remember our mortality by marking our foreheads with ashes, and then we go to the table for the Lord's Supper. We admit our need before God, and God gives freely. It's the foundation of our faith as Christians.

Even before we of OSLC started gathering for worship every Wednesday evening during the school year with Wednesday Word, it had been the tradition of our congregation to gather on the Wednesday evenings of the Lenten season. That tradition continues still. During the Wednesday evenings of Lent, we gather for supper beginning at 5:16 P.M., and then move into the sanctuary for a brief time of worship together in the sanctuary at 6:26 P.M. Once again, we will use the **Holden Evening Prayer** liturgy and its beautiful music as the foundation of our time together, letting Jesus' journey to the cross from the Gospel of Luke be our guide.

Plan on joining us this year. Use this time to commit yourself to a deeper examination of your faith and what it means to accompany Jesus through and in the midst of the craziness of this world as it is. It might just be that Easter will spring forth for you in a new way.







January 3, 2025 - 6:30 PM

OUR MISSION: Inspired by God's grace, we open our hearts to all in faith, prayer, fellowship, and service through Jesus Christ.

- 1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Andy Binder at 6:11 PM. Members present were Deming Haugland, Dave Pummel, Brady Harr, Christina Miles, Reed Haug, Mike Steffen, Karson Klein, Pam Tyma, Sherry Kloeckl, Andy Binder, with Deacon Laura Campbell, and Pastor Stephan Sandness.
- 2. Devotions: Pastor Stephan shared an opening devotion.
- **3. Approve Agenda:** Christina Miles moved to approve the agenda as presented; Pam Tyma seconded; motion carried.
- 4. Approval of the December Council Minutes: Christina Miles moved to approve the November Council minutes as presented; Sherry Kloeckl seconded; motion carried.
- 5. Approval of the December Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Dave Pummel presented the treasurer's report provided. December income was \$94,535.81 with expenses of \$52,195.16. Year-to-date income stands at \$639,630.54 with expenses of \$604,734.69. Leaving a year-to-date balance of \$34,895.85, which is far better than last year. Not included in the above expenses is our planned mission support giving of \$9,671.00. Overall, this year has been excellent. Dave did make note we have seen approximately \$35,000 in donations for the fellowship hall heat pump replacement. Pam Tyma moved to approve the report as presented; Karson Klein seconded; motion carried.
- 6. Distribution of Mission Support Fund: Dave Pummel moved to split this year's mission support fund of \$9,671.00 evenly between St. Dysmas of South Dakota, Artemis House, & Woyatan Lutheran's warming bus program. Mike Steffen Second. Discussion pointed out this plan allows for local, regional, and state giving. Motion carried.
- 7. Ministerial Staff Reports: Deacon Laura and Pastor Stephan shared their gratitude for everyone's servant leadership and guidance over the past year. It was noted we had 1,032 people in total attend our Christmas Eve services. This has been a great end to a year of extraordinarily strong attendance and many new members.
- 8. Committee Reports: Education council has been communicating and preparing for the spring education season. The Properties committee reports on various repairs and projects around the building with expected heat pump replacement soon.
- **9.** Adjourn: The meeting adjourned by unanimous agreement at 6:31 PM followed by the Lord's Prayer. The next meeting will be held on February 11, 2025.
